

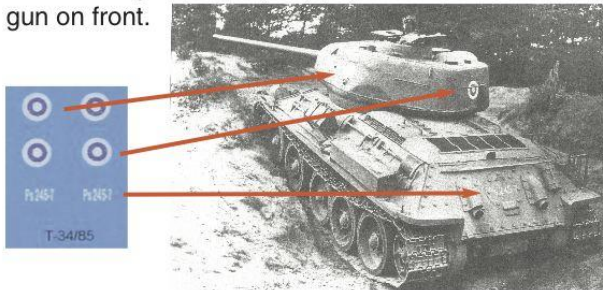


## Finnish Army, post WW2 72015

In general, the different insignia on Finnish tanks, both during and after WW2, were as follows: on tanks, the national emblem was displayed on the sides and the back of the turret. The emblem sometimes was displayed on the front of the hull, normally over the left fender. The tank's registration number was found in the centre of the back and front, sometimes in the front on the right, above or below the machine gun or driver port. When without a turret, the national emblem was displayed on the hull sides and sometimes the front. Colour schemes: Russian green, a camouflage of dull black, grey and light olive.

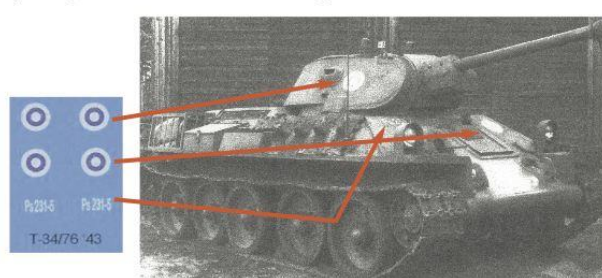
### T34/85

Number Ps 245-7, of PsR at Parolannummi, summer 1952. National emblems on back and sides of turret and above left front fender. Ps registration code on engine hatch (back) and above machine gun on front.



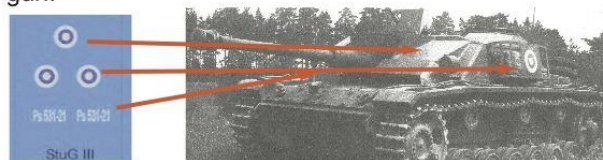
### T34/76 model 1940

Number Ps 231-1, Jyväskylä 1959. National emblems on back and sides of turret and above left front fender. Ps registration code on engine hatch (back) and above machine gun on front.



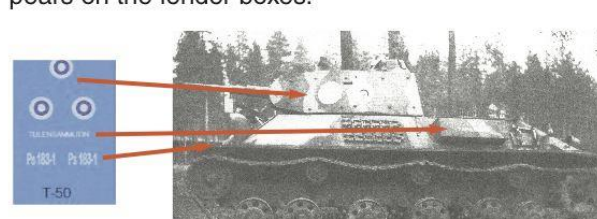
### StuG III

Number Ps 531-21, of PsR at Parolannummi, summer 1955. National emblems on back and sides of hull, and to the left of the gun. Ps registration code on middle of back and on shielding to lower right of gun.



### T50

Number Ps 183-1, at SteknV depot in Jyväskylä, autumn 1945. National emblems on back and sides of turret. Ps registration code on middle of back and above machine gun on front. The vehicle's name appears on the fender boxes.



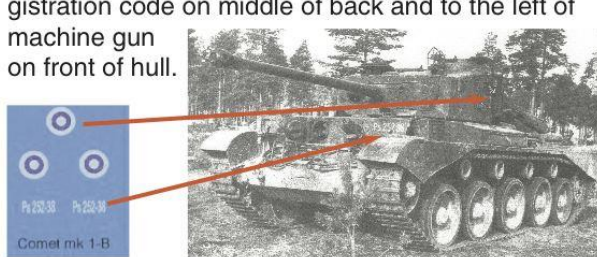
### PzKpfw IV Ausf. J

Number Ps 221-5, of PsR at Parolannummi, summer 1955. National insignia on back and sides of turret. Ps registration code on middle of back and above machine gun on front.



### Comet Mk1-B

Number Ps 252-38, of PohPr in Oulu, summer 1962. National insignia on back and sides of turret. Ps registration code on middle of back and to the left of machine gun on front of hull.



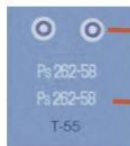
### BTR-60PB

Number Ps 673-62, of PO, summer 1984. National insignia on sides of turret and in middle of front. Ps registration code on middle of back and hull nose. The unit emblem is on the oblique nose side, the Uncle Scrooge emblem hangs from the grab handles.



### T-55

Number Ps 262-58, summer 1978. National insignia on back and sides of turret. Ps registration code on middle of back and front hull.



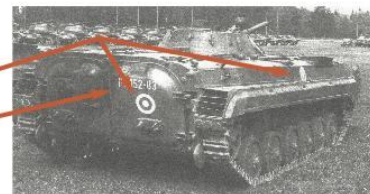
### 2S1 Gvozdika

Number Ps 251-61, autumn 1992. National insignia on sides of turret. Ps registration code on middle of back and hull nose.



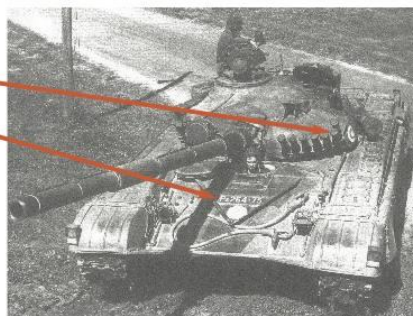
### BMP-1

Number Ps 151-271. National insignia on sides of hull and on right side hatch at back, below registration code. Other registration code on middle of hull nose.



### T-72M1

Number Ps 264-75. National insignia on sides and back of turret. Ps registration code on middle of back and below driver's hatch.
